### Do you have an editorial calendar?

No, we review wines from around the world throughout the year.

# When should I submit my wine for review?

To best serve our readers, we prefer to review wines as they are being released on the market. Due to the lead time needed in publishing and the time it takes to process submissions, we ask that you submit your wines approximately 1-3 months before the US release date.

### My wines are not currently being imported into the US. Can I still submit?

Unfortunately not. At this time, we are only able to consider wines that have a current US importer, as these have the most direct relevance to our readers. Once you acquire a US importer we encourage you to reach out for submission instructions.
